- Choose a topic that is relevant to Mind Remake Project's audience and that you are knowledgeable and passionate about.
- Offer a unique perspective or angle on your topic.
- Submission must be your original work, not-AI generated, and not previously published elsewhere.
- Submission must be well-written and easy to read.
- Aim for 1,000-2,000 words.
- Write in a style that is clear, simple, and concise. Be specific and include examples when applicable.
- Use subheadings.
- Keep your paragraphs short and use bullet points as needed.
- Submissions should include practical tips or guidelines.
- Submissions should include references (unless writing about personal experience).
- Submissions should include resource links and/or downloadable worksheets/handouts (unless writing about personal experience).
- Self-promotion within the post is not allowed. You may link to your site in your bio.
- Include a short bio and headshot.
